



RECORDINGS IN ST JOHN'S COLLEGE CHAPEL

Hirers of St John's College Chapel may like to consider purchasing a CD recording of their event. Recordings can be made using the professional audio equipment installed for the College's webcasting service.

For a basic fee of £300, the College would record and produce a single master CD of up to one hour in length (a standard CD contains a maximum of 18 tracks additional tracks will be charged at £10.00 each). For events lasting more than one hour, additional master CDs will be required and these will be charged at £50.00 each.

Requests for a recording must be made at the time of booking the Chapel. A deposit of £100 will be required at this stage. Shortly after the event has taken place, a five minute sample CD will be provided for your approval. The balance of £200 will become payable on completion of a full master CD.



Microphone Details



- Point A – 2 omni-directional microphones mounted on a trapeze to the East of the Choir – facing East
- Point B – 2 cardioids microphones set on a trapeze West of the Choir Stalls – facing East
- Point B – 2 omni-directional microphones set at a trapeze West of the Choir Stalls – facing East
- Line in feed of the PA system at 7 static points
- Line in feed of the PA system 2 additional sockets
- 2 omni-directional microphones mounted on the screen at the West of Chapel – pointing west
