## 2012 Clare College Chamber Music Composition Competition

Clare College is pleased to announce the third year of its annual competition for the composition of chamber music, open to all undergraduates of Cambridge University.

The top three winning entries will be workshopped with Giles Swayne (Composer-in-Residence, Clare College) and Graham Ross (Director of Music, Clare College) in the Lent Term 2012. The winning composer will receive a prize of £100, and will have his/her work performed in recital in Clare College Chapel by Clare musicians on Sunday 4 March 2012 at 5.30 p.m.

Submissions must be scored for either three, four or five of the following instruments:  
**clarinet, trumpet, trombone, violin and 'cello.**

Scores must be no longer than **six minutes duration** (without repeats), and should be submitted anonymously in handwritten notation by **9am, Monday 13 February 2012** to Graham Ross, Director of Music, Clare College.
