

2018 Clare College Chamber Music Composition Competition

First prize: £400 and a concert performance

Second prize: £200

Clare College announces its 7th Chamber Music Composition Competition, open to all undergraduates of Cambridge University. Composers Giles Swayne and Graham Ross will give an open workshop of the top three winning entries in the 2018 Lent Term. The winning composer will receive a prize of £400, and will have his/her work performed in recital in Clare College Chapel by Clare musicians on Sunday 4 March 2018 at 5.25 p.m.

Submissions must be scored for **two violins and piano** (or a combination of two of these).

Scores must be no longer than **six minutes duration** (without repeats), and must be submitted anonymously with a pseudonym by **9am**, **Wednesday 24 January 2018** to Graham Ross, Director of Music, Clare College. Included in the submission should be sealed envelope which contains the composer's pseudonym and real identity.*
