Jess will talk about the neurological condition Tourettes, which causes her to say 'biscuit' up to 16,000 times a day, and the power of humour and art to create change.

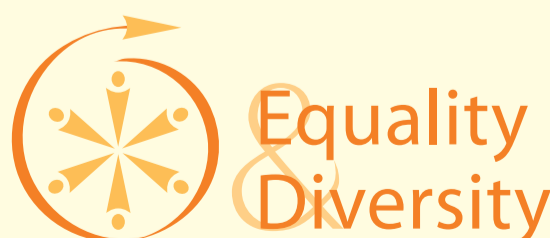
