

Written Work Requirements for History and Modern Languages

You should submit two pieces of written work. The first of these should be a piece of work you have written as part of your school History course, or for another essay subject. Typically, this will take the form of an essay. This can include coursework, extended projects, and timed work written in class as well as homework essays.

If you are applying to study a language at Cambridge which you are studying for A level or equivalent, the second piece of work should be written in that language.

If you are applying to study a language from scratch (ab initio), the second piece of work should be in any other foreign language you are currently studying, or in English if you are not studying any languages at present.

Please send the essay along with the cover sheet provided, which must be signed by you and your school/college. We will send you a link so you can scan and email your work to us, together with the signed cover sheet, to arrive by the **deadline of Wednesday 8 November**.

If you have any difficulties using the link we send you, you can send a hard copy by mail to The Admissions Office, St John's College, Cambridge CB2 1TP to arrive by the deadline of **8 November**. Please note you should send a photocopy of your work, not the original, as we do not return work.
