SJCS/2 Lady Margaret Boat Club (LMBC)

The Lady Margaret Boat Club (LMBC) was founded in the October (Michaelmas) term of 1825 by 12 members of the College. SJC was the first College to have an eight-oared boat on the river, though Trinity had had a four-oared boat a short time before the LMBC was founded. The first club consisted of 18 members.

The Club's first Captain was Richard Le Poer Trench. Initially the club and rowing were merely for recreation, not competition.

The Club was governed by a committee of five members elected every term, who chose from among themselves a president, treasurer and secretary.

Rowing was not carried out throughout the whole term but between fixed dates. Members were fined for being absent.

The first boat in 1827 was named Dolphin.

There was, however, institutional continuity.

The St. John's College Pig Club was founded on 4 September 1946, and was an embodiment of the saying 'waste not, want not'. Pig Clubs all over the country had, during the Second World War, helped the national effort by encouraging home-grown meat from beasts fattened on an economical, but to them congenial, diet of edible waste. The College had contributed to this effort by fattening pigs in the Kitchen Garden during the War, but it was not until after its end that a pig club was formed.

In the times of rationing it was suggested by the late Prof. Glyn Daniel, the world-famous archaeologist and Fellow of the College, who had had experience of R.A.F. pig clubs, that St. John's should set up one of its own. This had the double aim of providing the College Kitchen with pork, and continuing to aid the supply of the nation through sales of pigs to the Ministry of Food.

The club was begun with a modest capital advance of £100 from the College Steward, and a stock of twelve pigs bought from the College Kitchen garden. Subscription to the Club was one shilling a year, and six-monthly meetings were held to discuss all aspects of the management of pigs.

The original purpose of the Club ended with the end of food rationing in 1954; but its total demise was resisted by a loyal membership. It was agreed at a meeting on 11 June 1954 to continue the Club (minus its livestock) as a gathering 'for social and unspecified purposes as a glorious anomaly'. Since then its meetings have been a forum for all kinds of learned and jocular debate, and valuable reminiscences, in which Fellows and Staff participate together; with periodic displays of an array of pig mascots in many media, provided by the members.

SJCS/28 The Lady Margaret Players

The Lady Margaret Players is a College amateur dramatic society which was formed early in the Lent Term 1949, out of those associated with a production of T.S. Eliot's 'Murder in the Cathedral', in the College Chapel at Christmas 1948. Its original purpose was primarily to provide a niche for medieval and modern religious drama - perceived as inadequately catered for in the University dramatic scene. It was also hoped to attract Johnian thespians lured by the bright lights of University dramatic clubs to a specifically College society which they could consider their own: and to exploit the resources of some of the unproduced plays lying in the recesses of the College Library. The religious plays would be produced each December in the Chapel, the unsung examples of

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the Art during May Week. It was also hoped that Johnians would write new plays for future production.

Among the members of the founding committee were Frank Thistlethwaite, Fellow and Tutor, an historian and economist, Peter Gardom Croft (B.A.1948), who read English and went on to be ordained in the Church of England, John Boyd Denson (B.A.1949) who pursued a career in the diplomatic service, and Michael William Stephens (B.A.1948), who joined the BBC.

After the inaugurating production of 'Murder in the Cathedral', the society presented in May Week 1949 in the Fellows' Garden, an abridgement of three comedies, 'Parnassus', written and first performed by members of the College between 1598 and 1602. It thus revived the tradition of College drama which had flourished in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, following it up in May Week 1951 with 'The Humorous Lovers' by William Cavendish Duke of Newcastle (M.A.1608). In the early years the Christian commitment of the society continued to be apparent, with such productions as 'Christ's Comet' - about the Epiphany - by Christopher Hassall in 1949, and 'The Zeal of Thy House' by Dorothy L. Sayers, in 1950. Its activity now covers a wide variety of plays ancient and modern.

The Willows [Cricket] Club existed to serve the needs of College members who did not aspire to a College team, or who were too committed to other sports, but would enjoy an occasional game of cricket. The idea was that the Secretary or Captain pinned an appropriate team-sheet on the College notice board, and the first 11 Johnians to sign it comprised the team for the following Saturday; others could volunteer to be scorers or umpires. The Club's opponents were nearby village teams, particularly those with attractive pitches on village greens, and which were flanked by village inns. According to one village the club was referred to as The Willows because the teams would play for a bit of broken cricket bat - that was the trophy. The club is known to have been in existence 1949-1970.
