



CONSTABLE ESSAY PRIZE

Submissions are invited for the Constable Essay Prize from undergraduate members of the College (including affiliated students). The prize has a value of £120.

Candidates may submit works of scholarship or the results of any research that they have undertaken on a topic within the physical sciences. For this year it has been decided that reports written as part of summer research projects will be eligible.

Submissions should not be more than 3000 words, and should be accompanied by a declaration that the submission is the candidate's own original and unaided work, and has not been submitted in any University examination, nor for any University Prize or other College Prize.
