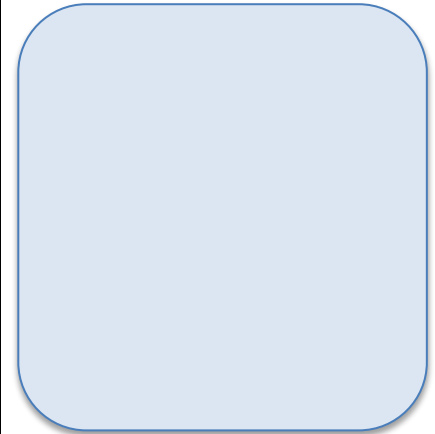

The application pack should include:

- Transcripts of your University qualifications giving details of the courses taken and results obtained.
- A recent sample of your academic work. This should be in the form of an essay or other coursework. Please do not submit more than one piece of academic work and we would encourage you to submit the one that demonstrates best your academic capabilities and your suitability for the course you are applying for.
- Certificates of your secondary school qualifications.
- Copies of letters from Student Finance England, for the duration of your undergraduate studies.

E-mail the "Applicant Recommendation Form" to your two referees and ask them to send their references by the closing date of 2nd November 2020, either by e-mail to john.crook.scholarship@joh.cam.ac.uk or by mail to the address given above.

It is expected that shortlisted candidates will be asked to attend an interview on **Monday 16th November 2020**.
